**2025 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FOR
UNDERGRADUATE AND GRADUATE STUDIES**

St. George offers a diverse selection of higher education scholarships that are sponsored by generous donors to college students for continuing their education on the undergraduate or graduate level.

In order to be considered, it is required that the applicant's family be members in good standing of St. George Greek Orthodox Church of Ocean Township, NJ. Submissions must be fully complete with all required documents, transcripts, test results (if applicable), letters of recommendation (if applicable), and essays. Applications must be submitted to the St. George Church Office no later than **Sunday, May 25, 2025**. An awards ceremony will immediately follow Divine Liturgy on Sunday, June 22, 2025. Please make every effort to attend.

Scholastic Awards and Scholarships are offered every year to eligible students. There are three levels of awards and scholarships, including: 1) graduating high school seniors; 2) undergraduate students; and 3) graduate level students. Please note that students may only apply **one time** per academic level. Multiple submissions at the same level will be ineligible.

Incomplete applications that do not adhere to the requirements will be deemed ineligible. Please note the following requirements and regulations below:

- 1. The deadline for all applications is firm. Incomplete applications and supporting documents will not be considered if received after the deadline.*
- 2. Applicants will only be considered for the scholarship that is indicated by a checkmark on this application, and for which there is a corresponding essay. Please note the scholarship name at the top of each essay.*
- 3. All information presented and included with each application shall be kept confidential and shared among the scholarship committee members during the selection process.*
- 4. To ensure a fair consideration process, the names of the applicants are redacted, and each application is reviewed blindly by the committee and scored on a rubric scale. Committee members do not know the identity of the applicant prior to and during the reviewing and scoring process. Applicants are asked to refrain from placing their names anywhere other than where indicated in this application.*
- 5. Please note that there may be specific criteria for each scholarship listed. Please ensure that you meet those criteria before choosing to apply. Please refer to the descriptions under each scholarship heading for reference.*
- 6. Submitted applications must use this application form. Modification of this application will result in ineligibility.*
- 7. Digital applications will not be accepted. Applications in their entirety can either be mailed or dropped off at the Church Office.*

Criteria: For students currently attending Hellenic College/Holy Cross School of Theology and declaring Seminarian status.
Essay: Explain why you have decided to become a Seminarian, or share something insightful regarding your present experience as a Seminarian.
- Spiro and Helen Michals and John and Helen Morris Memorial Scholarship**
Criteria: Undergraduate studies.
Essay: These founding members of our St. George Community were dedicated and committed to making our community what it is today. Describe how the St. George Community has influenced your life, and how you plan on giving back to the Community.
- Philoptochos Graduate Memorial Scholarship**
Criteria: This scholarship is specifically for students at the graduate (Master or Doctoral) level. The applicant's mother and/or grandmother must be a current active member of Philoptochos in good standing for at least the past two years. In addition, the applicant MUST have graduated college and is entering the first year of graduate school pursuing a master's degree, or has obtained a master's degree and is entering the first year of a doctoral level program. This scholarship will be awarded based on financial need and academic merit as well.
